



A site that I've just upgraded from 4.8 to 4.12.234 is now experiencing an LDAP connection failure. The configuration is shown below. I've noted the password invalidation error in EWEB-31218 - we've reset the account and re-entered the password. I've also run the EWEB-28485 patch, although I assume that this patch should have been captured in 4.11 and 4.12? Still getting a connection test failure. Any ideas?

The issue I am seeing is the Manager Account field. The backend on this was changed - it now requires that the DN of the manager account user is used here, rather than the name. Please try the DN and let me know if that works for you.
